

#### From the Diary of Sister Faustina:

On that day the depths of my tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of my mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. **On that day are open all the divine floodgates through which graces flow**. Let no soul fear to draw near to me, even though its sin be scarlet. My mercy is go great that no mind, be it man or angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Every thing that exists has come from the very depths of my tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to me will contemplate my love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from my very depths of tenderness. It is my desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy."




